



PVC or PE poster

Material: PVC front lit or PE(PVC-free)

In case of a PVC poster – the channels meant for fixing fillets at every edge must be present. Channels must be bended back and sewn/welded, open at both ends and with a width of 7cm.

PVC fabric should be at least 450 g/m², 350-400 g/m² is laminated fabric, which does not last in climate conditions. Printing house is responsible for quality of fabric.

PVC poster

Material: PVC back lit for outdoor use

10 cm from every edge to be left without important texts or other information, because the edges will be covered with the frame profile.

Metal eyelets for fastening with diameter of 1-1,5cm, external diameter 2,5cm, at each edge with spans of 20 cm. To be installed on double edges bent back, with width of max 7 cm. Distance of center of eyelet from edge 2 cm, the distance of the first eyelet from the edge of corners 7 cm. No eyelets can be placed in the corners.

PVC fabric should be at least 450 g/m², 350-400 g/m² is laminated fabric, which will not last in climate. Printing house is responsible for quality of fabric. Recommended to check out fabric before printing.





- Top&bottom eyelets: First eyelet 45mm from the corner. After that with a step of 372mm.
